Finding True Peace

TRUE LOVE

You can never have enough of Peace. All the money in the world may give you some kind of happiness but not peace. Money can't buy it, you can not find it in schools nor in churches, you cannot secure it in a vault, nor be prescribed to you by doctor.

But Jesus says I have peace that the world cannot give so don't be worried nor afraid, (*John 14:27*)

What kind of Peace are we looking for?

There is a difference from the peace we talk about and the Peace Jesus is offering us. We talk about peace in terms of Wars, that the world is experiencing today. We say we will experience peace as soon as are able to control or put an end to war. But is that really the peace we need?

The peace Jesus is offering goes beyond the physical peace that we are looking for.

We are looking for a complete peace that only Jesus offer.
The Peace we need today a peace of mind.

How can we get Peace that Jesus offers. Firstly, we need to recognize who we are and who Jesus is.

This means the first step is to recognize that we are sinners in need of a Saviour



means that we see the need for us to

confess to Jesus that we are sinners. Then, next thing we are to do after realizing who we are is we need to confess to God and Pray to Him asking Him to wash away our sins and to give us a fresh start in Him. The third we need to do is then to just believe in His Promises.

What are promises to us?

Firstly God wants us to act on God's promises that He gives us. Remember. The man who was brought on a stretcher to Jesus and his friends brought him down through the roof before Jesus in *Luke 5:24-25*.

Jesus said for him to get up, take up your bed and walk...He took and went home.

The sick man had to act on what Jesus told him, if he didn't he would still be laying there on the bed. We need to act on God's word.

Secondly believing on God's

Word is very important to have true peace. We can say I believe and not act on it and we will not have peace.

Mark 11:24 says, Jesus says, "...whatever you ask for in prayer, believe that you have received it and it will be yours." This is the assurance that God gives us that if you believe in what we pray for to God, He will give whatever we ask that is in accordance with His will. That will give us the peace of mind knowing that we have asked in accordance with God's will.

Does that mean I will have no problems? So now that God has assured me that whatever we ask in God's name He will provide, I am free from the problems of this world is what you may be thinking now.

Remember we are still living in a world of sin which means that we will continue to experience problems that will not give us peace. God wants us to commit ourselves totally to Him, that by doing so, though we experience problems in this imperfect world, we know that we serve a perfect
